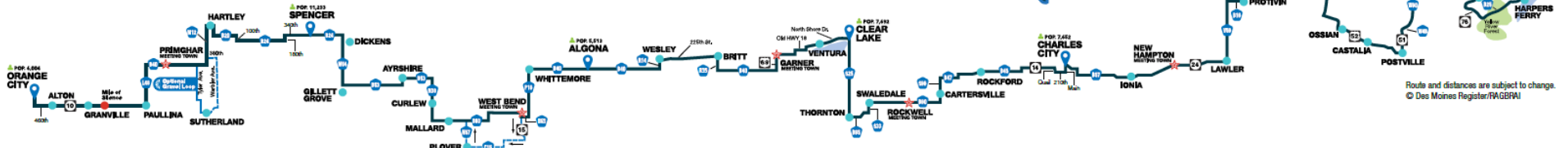


Iowa's county engineers caution cyclists that the secondary roads are primarily designed and maintained for motorized vehicular traffic and not necessarily for narrow-wheeled bicycles. The winter and spring weather can be brutal on our road system. A rider may encounter an occasional random crack, pothole, loose granular material or difference in elevation that could pose a problem. With this in mind, if riders are attentive and travel at a safe speed, they should enjoy a comfortable ride across Iowa. We urge all riders to stick to the designated bike routes.
